

Orthodontics and Braces



What is an Orthodontist? This special type of Dentist is focused on fixing your bite and straightening your teeth.

Are braces included in my plan?

Yes, if medically necessary in order to fix a serious problem.



Visit your General Dentist for a check up twice a year (every six months).



If your Dentist sees issues with your bite, crowding, spacing or chewing, they will send you to an Orthodontist for a consultation.



If you have a qualifying condition, the Orthodontist will discuss your possible treatment options.



If you meet the requirements for braces, the office will send in all related documents including x-rays for review.

Not all cases will be approved. You have the right to file a complaint at any time. You have the right to appeal, but appeals may not change the decision if the requirements are still not met.
